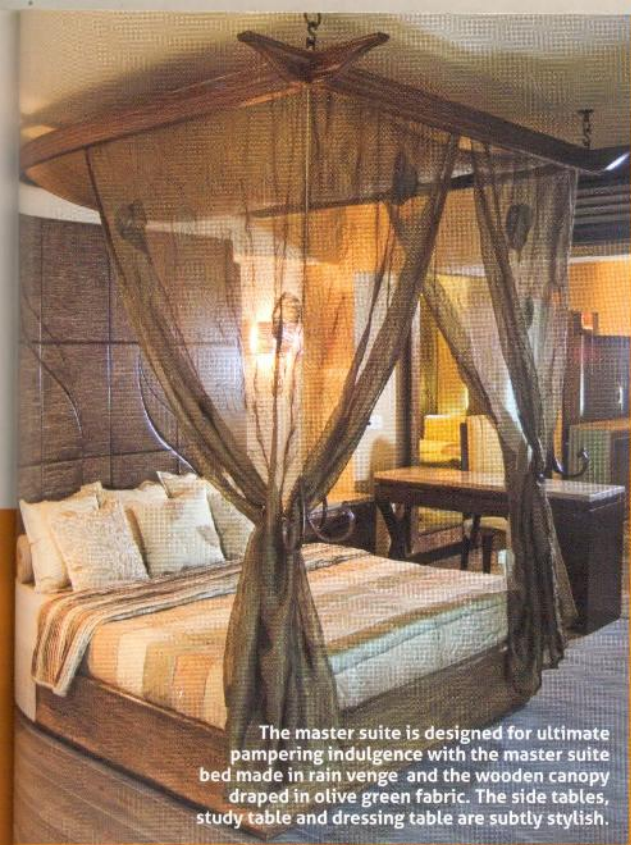
Or to get a serene feel of elegance coupled with bliss, take a look at the Autumnal Equinox Collection. Resort

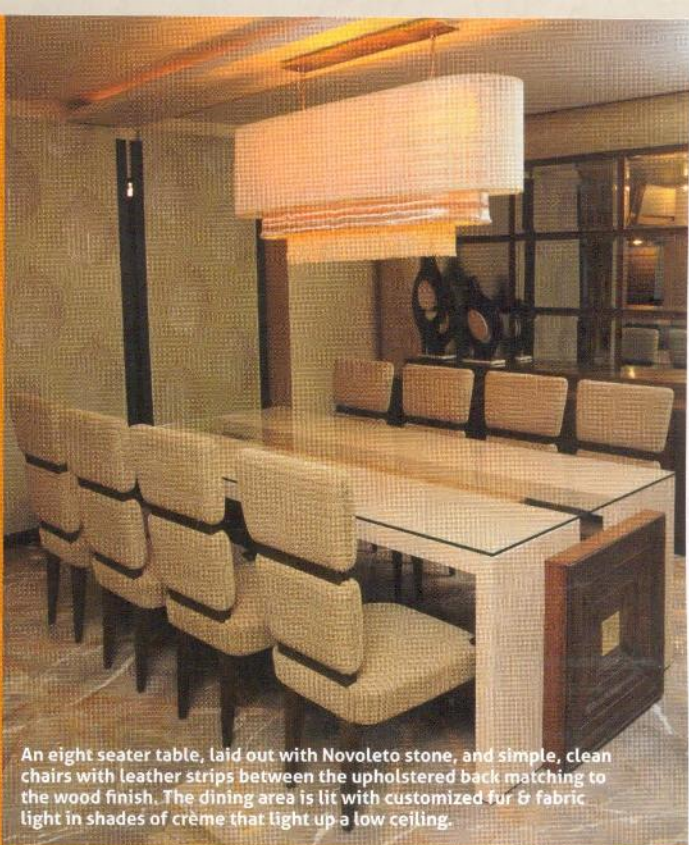
For the avant-garde, a space is a masterpiece waiting to happen, and masterpieces are created à la Sorogeeeka!



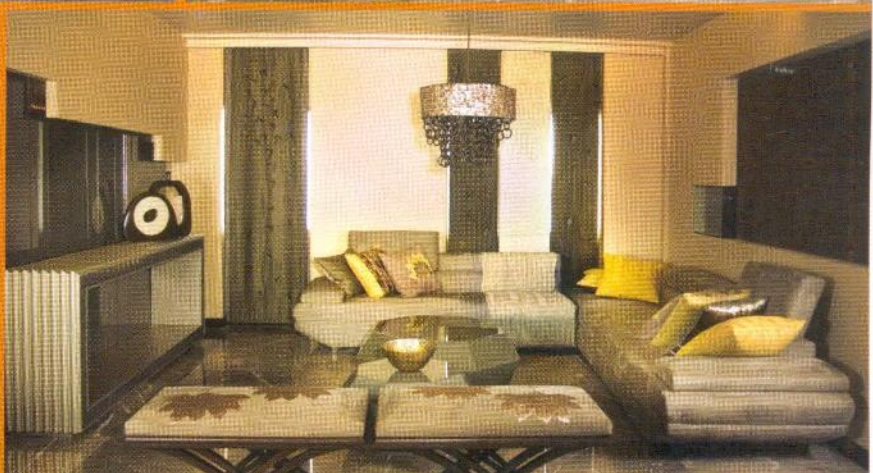
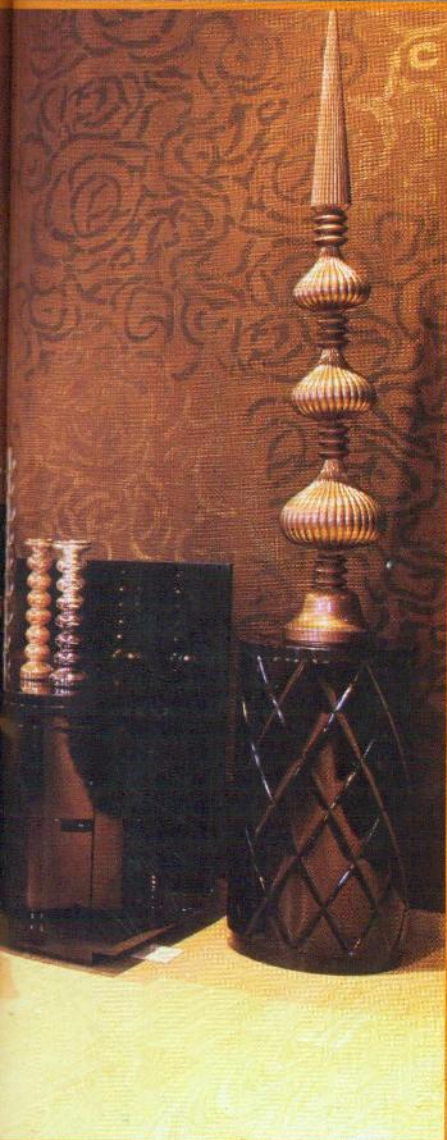
